RE: Inspection, Test and Service of Survitec – Survitec Group Inflatable Liferafts

Under IMO SOLAS Resolution A761(18) [as amended] it is a requirement that all liferaft service stations are approved jointly by the manufacturer and the flag state. It is also a requirement that the service personnel are trained by the manufacturer and the manufacturer's spares and service manuals are maintained by the Service Station. It is also a requirement that Solas Liferafts are only serviced at manufacturer authorized service stations.

Survitec Group will only support service stations that have been authorized and their personnel trained by Survitec

Survitec Group do not and will not supply manufacturer's spares or technical support to un-authorized service stations, Survitec Group will not accept any responsibility for our manufactured liferafts that may malfunction as a result of un-authorized servicing.

It should also be noted that if during a Port State Control Inspection evidence of un-authorized liferaft servicing is found the vessel may be detained until such time the liferaft has been correctly serviced.

It has been brought to Survitec Group attention other service stations on Sint Maarten are masquerading as approved service stations servicing and recertifying rafts which are manufactured by Survitec Group. This is to advise the under mentioned company is the only Survitec approved service station located on Sint Maarten
